The Treaty Tree
Grosse Ile July 6, 1776

“This stone marks the location of the Treaty Tree and commemorates the conveyance by treaty of Grosse Ile (known to the Indians as Nitche-Minishon) and adjacent islands to William and Alexander Macomb by the Pottawatomie Indians. The treaty was signed by eighteen chiefs for the Pottawatomie nation of Indians on July 6, 1776. — The events of the past shape the pathway of the future. — Erected by the Woman's Improvement Association of Grosse Ile, 1906. — The deed is recorded in the Register of Detroit No.2, Vol. 6, A10.”
